

# **GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION (Free Papers)**

All abstracts must be submitted through the Barany 2024 website at https://www.barany2024uppsala.com/abstracts/


Please follow the steps making sure to carefully complete all sections. If all sections are not completed, your abstract submission will **NOT** be accepted.

#### 1. Rules for abstract submission

- A. Authors are required to indicate their preference for either oral or poster presentation by checking the appropriate box on the submission web page. The Scientific Committee, however, reserves the right to make the final decision on the type of presentation.
- B. Acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be based on rankings given by a peer review of experts in the associated subspecialties. Results of the selection process will be sent out via e-mail. The reviewers' decision is final and cannot be appealed.
- C. Instructions on the preparation of posters and oral presentations will be published on the congress website in June 2024.
- D. Submission of an abstract indicates acceptance of and compliance with the abstract submission rules, the scientific validity of the presentation and that all authors have read and approved the abstract and its
- E. All accepted abstracts will be published and distributed to all delegates.
- F. Accepted abstracts are official communications to the meeting. The presenting author agrees to register, attend the meeting and present the abstracts as scheduled. The presenting author **must register at the time of acceptance of his or her abstract**. Abstracts accepted with no registered participants **by May 30, 2024** will not be published.
- G. The Barany 2024 Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject abstracts that do not observe the above mentioned rules.
- H. The Barany 2024 Scientific Committee will review all submitted abstracts. The reviewing process is confidential and decision is final.

## 2. Instructions for abstract preparation

In order for you to submit an abstract, you must first register as a "New submitter". You will then receive an e-mail with login instructions.



### A. Abstracts must be written and presented in English.

B. **Title**: Use a concise title that indicates the content of the abstract. The complete title should not exceed **100 characters**. Refrain from using abbreviations in the title.

**Authors**: Names and surnames for each author must be provided. Do not include degrees or titles. Presenting authors' name will be published in bold.



**Affiliations**: Each author should be listed by University/Hospital, Department and Country. Please make sure to include this complete information in the Affiliation text box.

Contents: Abstracts should not exceed 250 words in total. Abstracts will be reproduced exactly as submitted and will not be edited in any way. Contents are organized in the following text boxes: Purpose, Methods, Results and Conclusions. It is not satisfactory to simply state that "The result will be discussed". Only standard abbreviations may be used without definition. Drug products should be identified by their generic name only. Data must be given in units (International metric system is preferred) widely used in literature.

**Keywords**. Include three to five words or phrases.

No references, tables, charts or drawings are allowed.

C. Only a limited number of abstracts selected by the Scientific Committee will be presented as oral presentations. Others will be accepted as posters.

Only one category may be chosen. The Scientific Committee will attempt to respect the authors' choice regarding their self-assignment to a special topic, but it reserves the right to change the allocation in order to achieve a well-balanced scientific program.
